Beginning January 1, 2009 the MDS will be the reimbursement tool to establish the Medicaid direct patient care rate. All residents (regardless of payor source) will be included in establishing the rate from January 1, 2009 and March 31, 2009. Beginning April 1, 2009, Medicaid-only MDS's will be utilized to establish the Medicaid rate. This program will provide long term care personnel the most recent and relevant information regarding the New York State's Medicaid Case Mix and MDS. Soon to be released by the NYSDOH will be the state's interpretation and promulgation of the MDS. The program will focus on this interpretation and its impact on your facility, from a financial, clinical and rehabilitation perspective.
